Entry Requirements

Diploma of Nursing (Enrolled / Division 2 Nursing) or equivalent.
Be eligible for enrolment as a nurse in Australia.

Note: Additional requirements apply for clinical placements including a National Police Clearance and a record of immunization against communicable disease. These will be provided at the student's expense.

Assessment Methods

Students must complete all units including theory, practical and competency assessments and any clinical placements in order to receive the qualification.

Vocational Placement

Some specialisation streams may involve vocational placement in an appropriate health care setting.

Note: Students are fully insured by Careers Australia College of Healthcare. There is no guarantee of employment arising from a vocational placement.
